## **Editorial**

**Phytologia Balcanica** is an international journal dedicated to plant biodiversity: history, contemporary status, evolution, utilization and protection. The Journal will not receive and publish anymore articles related to the fungal diversity; they will be handled by the newly established specialized journal *Mycologia Balcanica*.

This volume institutes several changes in the Journal: a new Editorial Board of 23 members from 13 countries; a new format and design; and new requirements to the authors which will be published yearly only in one issue (the first one) and are available in the Journal's web-site: *http://www.bio.bas.bg/~phytolbalcan/.* 

The articles after reviewing and the proofs will be sent to the authors chiefly electronically. That is why, a couple of additional e-mail addresses are put at their disposal: *phytobalcanica@yahoo.com*, *phytobalcanica@abv.bg*.

Authors willing to submit a paper for publication in the journal are encouraged to send also 1–3 highquality colour photographs of plants subject to their papers for the front cover. In case such photograph is selected, its author is eligible for one free copy of the respective volume of the Journal. The Editorial Board initiates presentation of the scientific botanical centres of the Balkan countries (structure of the organization, scientific staff, main fields of research, important recent publications, recent major scientific projects, etc.), in order to encourage cooperation on bilateral and European level. The Editorial Board hopes that this idea will be supported by the heads and representatives of these centres.

The last issue of each volume will publish a list of the reviewers of the published articles.

The Journal also publishes book reviews. Books for reviews shall be sent to the Editor-in-Chief.

All specialists interested in the Journal can subscribe for it. Subscription details are provided at the Journal's web-site. Authors willing to get their article in a pdf format can have it for some extra charge.

We are grateful to all who have chosen the Journal for publication of their scientific results and extend to them our invitation to continue to contribute to it in the future. We will be grateful for any suggestions and critical notes aimed at improving the quality of the Journal.
