### New name

#### *Campanulaceae*

*Campanula saonissia* Biel & Kit Tan, **nom. nov.**

≡ *Campanula samothracica* Biel & Kit Tan in *Phytologia Balcanica* **16**(3): 351 (2010) *nom. illegit. non Campanula samothracica* (Degen) Greuter & Burdet in *Willdenowia* **11**: 40 (1981).

**Holotype** (Biel & Kit Tan 2010): Greece. Samothraki, E-NE of Pachia Ammos, steep rocky slope above the coast, granitic gravel with phrygana dominated by *Satureja montana*, 140 m, 40°24'N, 25°37'E, 19.05.2010, *Biel* 10.672 (holotype C).

*Campanula samothracica* Biel & Kit Tan is an illegitimate published name, being a later homonym. We propose here a new name for this species: *C. saonissia*, after Saonissos, one of the island's most ancient names.
